
CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
OF AN EMERGENCY MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 29TH, 2016

The City Council of the City of West Columbia, Texas, convenes this the 29th day of June, 2016, at 9:00 p.m. in a special meeting in the Council Chambers, 512 E. Brazos, West Columbia, Texas.

1. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 9:00 p.m. by Mayor Kincannon. Present were Kincannon, Tindol, Maynor, Walker, Biedenfeld, City Manager Sutherland and City Secretary Kuban. Thomas was absent.
2. CONSIDER AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO CONDUCT REPAIRS TO REID RD. SEWER LINE: Sutherland briefed council on the Reid Rd. sewer line issue. A complaint was received that the road was falling off and was checked, but the flood event took place before repairs could be made. Shoring was ordered, but the hole got larger so Matula & Matula were contacted to assist with the repair. Quotes were submitted in excess of city manager's spending limit and there exists an imminent threat to public health and safety in that sanitary sewer services may be interrupted and the size of the hole the collapsed line has caused in the road is also a physical danger to citizens and vehicles if not repaired immediately. Council agreed that the line should be replaced from Bell St. to Marshall St. instead of just the immediate location of the Reid Rd. intersection and that the gravel bed and fabric wrap was not necessary. Estimate of \$62,969.10 was agreed to be the best option. Motion was made by Tindol to authorize the city manager to spend up to \$75,000 to make emergency repairs on sewer line at Reid Rd. and Bell. Motion was seconded by Walker. Maynor suggested to review the estimate thoroughly to deem all aspects necessary. With no further discussion, all voted Aye.
3. ADJOURN: Mayor Kincannon adjourned the meeting at 9:10 p.m.
