

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF SAID CITY, BY DELETING FROM THE LIST OF ONE-WAY STREETS WITHIN THE CITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 18-99 OF THE CODE, THE ONE-WAY DESIGNATION IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION OF THAT PORTION OF CLAY STREET WHICH LIES EAST OF 15TH STREET AND CONTINUING TO THE POINT OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH 14TH STREET, AND THE ONE-WAY DESIGNATION IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION OF 14TH STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH CLAY STREET AND CONTINUING TO THE POINT OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH BRAZOS AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS OR POLICIES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

Section One

The previously established one-way designation in an easterly direction of that portion of Clay Street which lies east of 15th Street and continues to the point of its intersection with 14th Street, and the one-way designation in a northerly direction of 14th Street from its intersection with Clay Street and continuing to the point of its intersection with Brazos Avenue shall be and is hereby deleted. The affected portions of Clay Street and 14th Street shall revert to being open to two-way traffic.

Section Two

The portions of Clay Street and 14th Street described in the preceding section shall be and are hereby deleted from the list of one-way streets and alleys maintained in the City Secretary's Office pursuant to Section 18-99 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of West Columbia, Texas.

Section Three

Any rules, ordinances, police regulations, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

Section Four

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the several provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any court of competent jurisdiction enters a final order which holds that any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this ordinance is invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then any such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and any such ruling shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

Section Five

This ordinance shall be effective and applicable immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of West Columbia.
