

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF SAID CITY, BY DELETING FROM THE LIST OF DESIGNATED SCHOOL ZONES WITHIN THE CITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 18-98 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA AND DIRECTING THAT THE LIST OF SUCH SCHOOL ZONES ON FILE WITH THE CITY SECRETARY FOR THE CITY BE AMENDED ACCORDINGLY, DELETING THE FOLLOWING SCHOOL ZONES: (1) CLAY STREET BETWEEN 14TH AND 15TH STREETS; (2) 15TH STREET BETWEEN CLAY AND EAST BERNARD STREETS; (3) EAST BERNARD BETWEEN 14TH AND 15TH STREETS; (4) WEST BERNARD FROM 17TH STREET TO BENNETT STREET; (5) BENNETT STREET FROM WEST BARNARD TO WEST JACKSON STREETS, AND (6) BROWN STREET BETWEEN WEST JACKSON AND WEST BERNARD STREETS; AND ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL ZONE DURING DESIGNATED HOURS WITH A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF TWENTY MILES PER HOUR IN AND UPON SOUTH 14TH STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH JIM HOGG STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH THE COUNTY LINE (COUNTY ROAD 701); PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS OR POLICIES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

Section One

The following previously established designated school zones shall be and are hereby deleted: (1) Clay Street between 14th and 15th Streets (2) 15th Street between Clay and East Bernard Streets; (3) East Bernard between 14th and 15th Streets; (4) West Bernard from 17th Street to Bennett Street; (5) Bennett from West Bernard to West Jackson Street; and (6) Brown Street between West Jackson and West Bernard Streets.

Section Two

The portions of streets described in the preceding section shall be and are hereby deleted from the list of designated school zones maintained in the City Secretary's Office pursuant to Section 18-98 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of West Columbia, Texas.

The list of designated school zones on file with the City Secretary's office as provided under Section 18-98 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of West Columbia, Texas, shall be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

- [1] Establishing a school zone during designated hours with a maximum speed limit of twenty miles per hour in and upon South 14th Street from its intersection with Jim Hogg Street to its intersection with the County Line (County Road 701)

Section Three

Any rules, ordinances, police regulations, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

Section Four

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the several provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any court of competent jurisdiction enters a final order which holds that any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this ordinance is invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then any such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and any such ruling shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

Section Five


This ordinance shall be effective and applicable immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of West Columbia.
