

ORDINANCE NO: 539

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF A LIST OF DESIGNATED CITY PARKS WITH THE CITY SECRETARY; DESIGNATING EXISTING CITY PARKS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, OR INFORMAL POLICIES OF THE CITY WHICH ARE IN ANY MANNER INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING THAT ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE CONSTITUTES A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

**Section One**

Chapter 21 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of West Columbia, Texas, shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows by adding:

**Section 21-10(g). Park Usage - General**

[Sections (a) through (f), unchanged]

(g) It shall be unlawful to possess or consume any alcoholic beverage in any city park except by permit issued by the City Manager. A permit for the use or the possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverage at the pavilion within a city park may only be issued with respect to a scheduled event, for which a written application has been submitted to the City Manager of the City of West Columbia at least ten (10) days prior to the proposed event. The application shall include, among other things, the following:

(i) The name and address of the organization proposing to hold the event and the name, address and telephone number of one or more responsible persons in that organization.

(ii) The name, date, time and purpose of the proposed event.

(iii) The estimated number of persons attending the proposed event.

(iv) The type of alcoholic beverage which will be served at the proposed event.

(v) A description of the general activities to be conducted at the proposed event.

(vi) Evidence of compliance with the requirement for attendance and supervision of the event by off-duty police officers of the West Columbia Police Department.

(vii) Payment of a clean-up deposit in an amount specified by the City Manager.

The issuance of an alcoholic beverage permit for a city park is strictly within the discretion of the City Manager who shall, in making that determination, take into account, among other things, all of the information required to be included in the application, and the nature and number of other activities which will or may be occurring in the park or in the vicinity of the park at the time of the occasion for which the permit is sought. Any and all applications for an alcoholic beverage permit shall be upon such form and contain such information as the City Manager, in his sole discretion, may, from time to time, require in addition to that specified.

**Sec. 21-13. Maintaining List of Designated Parks with the City Secretary**

The list of designated City Parks in the City of West Columbia, Texas, shall be maintained in the City Secretary's Office of the City of West Columbia, Texas.

**Section Two**

In accordance with and pursuant to Section 21-13 of the Code as amended by this ordinance, the City Council hereby designates the following tracts or parcels of land owned and maintained by the City for recreational use by the general public as City Parks:

- (a) First Capitol Park located at 1300 North 13<sup>th</sup> Street.
- (b) Town Park also known as Rosenwald School Park located at the corner of Clay and Broad Street.
- (c) Unity Park located at North 17<sup>th</sup> Street.
- (d) Loggins Street Park located at 800 Loggins Street.
- (e) The grounds of the Replica of the First Capitol of the Republic of Texas located at 247 East Brazos Avenue.
- (f) The American Legion grounds, specifically including the Veteran's Memorial.

**Section Three**

Any rules, ordinances, police regulations, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

**Section Four**

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the several provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any court of competent jurisdiction enters a final order which holds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this ordinance is invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then any such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and any such ruling shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

**Section Five**


Failure to observe and obey the ordinance adopted above shall constitute a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

**Section Six**


This ordinance shall be effective and applicable immediately from
