AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS, AMENDING THE LIST OF AREAS DESIGNATED FOR MOBILE OR MANUFACTURED HOMES WITHIN THE CITY AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 11-50[4], CHAPTER 11, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, "REGULATED VEHICLES; MANUFACTURED HOUSING, MOBILE HOMES, AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES; LICENSING, REGULATION, AND PARKS"; ADDING LOT 6 IN THE MOONEY HALL SUBDIVISION AS AN AREA DESIGNATED FOR MOBILE OR MANUFACTURED HOMES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, OR POLICIES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; CONTAINING A SERVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

Section One

Subsection [4] of Section 11-50 "Moving, replacement, substitution of occupied or connected manufactured or mobile home restricted", of Chapter 11, "REGULATED VEHICLES; MANUFACTURED HOUSING, MOBILE HOMES, AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES; LICENSING, REGULATION AND PARKS", of the Code of Ordinances, shall be and is hereby amended by the addition of Lot 6, and shall state as follows:

- [4] The manufactured home, or mobile home is situated within the boundaries of Lots 6, 7, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 in the Mooney Hall Subdivision.

Section Two

Any rules, ordinances, regulations, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.

Section Three

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the several provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any court of competent jurisdiction enters a final order which holds that any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this ordinance is invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then any such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and any such ruling shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

Section Four

This ordinance shall be effective and applicable immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of West Columbia, and the publication of its caption as provided by law.
