


CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
OF A SPECIAL MEETING
MONDAY, JULY 30, 2012

The City Council of the City of West Columbia, Texas, convenes this the 30th day of July, 2012, at 7:00 p.m. in a special meeting in the Council Chambers, 512 E. Brazos, West Columbia, Texas.

1. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Mayor Kincannon. Present were Kincannon, Schwebel, Walker, Biedenfeld, City Manager Sutherland and City Secretary Kuban. Absent were Tindol and Thomas.
2. CONSIDER RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION – HIGHWAY 35 SIDEWALKS: Sutherland reported that Capt. Darryl Tiner helped to complete the grant paperwork for funding sidewalks along West Brazos. The grant is an 80/20 matching funds grant and with an estimated total cost of \$640,000 the city's contribution would be approximately \$130,000. In-kind contribution options discussed were the use of city employees for labor, donations of benches and lights, etc. and partnering with local businesses. It was reported that the sidewalks could not be in a residential area. Motion was made by Walker, seconded by Schwebel to adopt Resolution No. 429 to submit transportation improvement program grant application. All voted Aye.
3. ADJOURN: Mayor Kincannon adjourned the meeting at 7:13 p.m.
