

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA TEXAS, AMENDING THE LIST THERE IS WHERE PARKING IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE CITY PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 18-160, 18-161 AND 18-164 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA AND DIRECTING THAT THE LIST OF SUCH PROHIBITED PARKING AREAS ON FILE WITH THE CITY SECRETARY OF THE CITY BE AMENDED ACCORDINGLY, PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF LOGGINS DRIVE BETWEEN ITS INTERSECTION WITH ROUGHNECK DRIVE AND ITS INTERSECTION WITH WEST TEXACO, AND PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF WEST TEXACO BETWEEN ITS INTERSECTION WITH LOGGINS DRIVE AND ITS INTERSECTION WITH WEST OAK STREET, WHICH AREAS ARE DESIGNATED AS A NO STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING ZONE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, OR POLICIES OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY ARE INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING THAT THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL CONSTITUTE AN OFFENSE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NO MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED AND 00/100'S DOLLARS (\$200.00); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST COLUMBIA, TEXAS:

Section One

The City hereby designates, pursuant to Sections 18-160, 18-161 and 18-164 of the Code of Ordinances of the City as a no stopping, standing or parking zone, the following:

- [1] on the West side of Loggins Drive between its intersection with Roughneck Drive and its intersection with West Texaco; and
- [2] on the North side of West Texaco between its intersection with Loggins Drive and its intersection with West Oak Street.

The list of streets on which parking is prohibited, is on file with the City Secretary pursuant to section 18-164 of the Code of Ordinances, shall be amended to include the areas designated above.

Section Two

The City Manager is expressly authorized and directed to obtain and have installed appropriate signs reflecting the traffic regulations adopted by this ordinance.

Section Three

Failure to observe and obey the traffic regulations adopted above and the signs erected pursuant to this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of no more than Two Hundred and 00/100's Dollars (\$200.00).

Section Four

Any rules, ordinances, police regulations, resolutions, and/or policies of the City of West Columbia, whether written, or otherwise, which are in any manner in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and/or inconsistency.


Section Five

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the several provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any court of competent jurisdiction enters a final order which holds that any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this ordinance is invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then any such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and any such ruling shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance which are not specifically designated as being illegal, invalid or unenforceable.

Section Six


This ordinance shall be effective and applicable immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of West Columbia, and the publication of its caption as provided by law.



Ordinance No. 520

An ordinance for the City of West Columbia Texas, amending the list there is where parking is prohibited within the City pursuant to sections 18-160, 18-161 and 18-164 of the code of ordinances of the City of West Columbia and direction that the list of such prohibited parking areas on file with the City Secretary of the City be amended accordingly, prohibiting parking on the West side of Loggins Drive between its intersection with Roughneck Drive and its intersection with West Texaco, and prohibiting parking on the North side of West Texaco between its intersection with Loggins Drive and its intersection with West Oak Street, which areas are designated as a no stopping, standing or parking zone; Providing for the repeal fo all ordinances, resolutions, or policies of the City of West Columbia to the extent that they are inconsistent or in conflict with this ordinance; containing a severability clause; providing that the violation of this ordinance shall constitute an offense punishable by a fine of no more than two hundred and 00/100's dollars (\$200.00); and providing an effective date.
